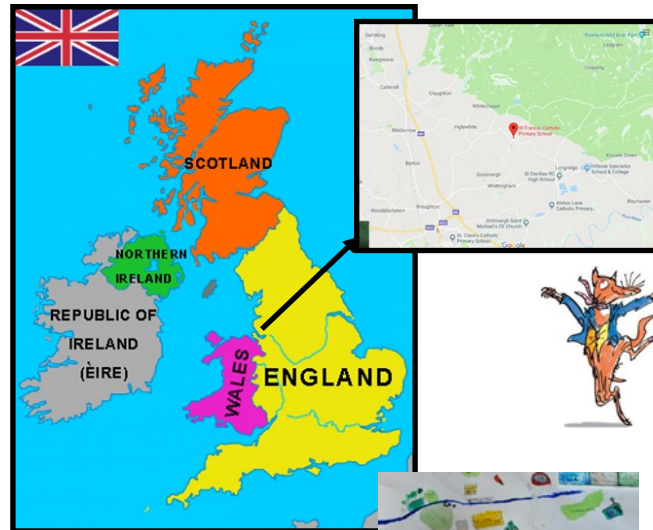

Creative Curriculum

Pupils will be participating in lots of Forest School activities every Wednesday afternoon. This exciting opportunity will allow pupils to create, explore and learn through our wonderful school surroundings using their imaginations, problem solving, D.T. and Art skills.

Literacy

This term pupils will be exploring the Roald Dahl story, 'Fantastic Mr Fox'. Pupils will develop their literacy skills through:

- Character studies
- Looking at the story's setting
- Asking and answering why, what, when, who, where, how questions.
- Participating in role play/drama activities.
- Developing their narrative writing by creating their own innovative story based on 'Fantastic Mr Fox'.
- Compose a letter
- Develop punctuation, grammar and spelling skills, e.g. Capital letters, full stops, adjectives, nouns etc.
- Apply phonics knowledge to spell words correctly.



Mathematics

Throughout this term pupils will be learning:

- Number and Place Value
- Measurement-Length/mass/weight.
- Addition and Subtraction
- Data, graphs and statistics
- Geometry- 2d and 3d shapes.



Topic

This term we will be taking a Geography/History focus within our topic lessons. We will be looking at our local area- Goosnargh, and see how it has changed over time. Children will develop their mapping skills through fieldwork identifying key physical and human features e.g. churches, roads, fields etc. Throughout the term pupils will have the opportunity to draw their own maps and design their own playground.

As well as our local area, we will be getting familiar with countries that make up the United Kingdom and locate them on a U.K. map.
