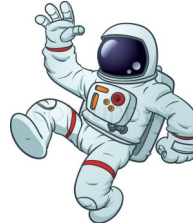

Space Explorers



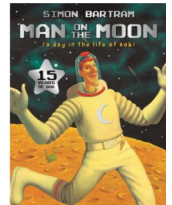
Topic

Parlick class are going to be space explorers this term. Discovering new worlds and going on exciting adventures meeting aliens, astronauts and moon trees. We will dive into our creative imaginations and also learn about significant explorers in history e.g. Neil Armstrong, the first man on the moon. We will look at rocket launches and learn about our universe full of stars, planets, milky ways, the moon and sun.



Literacy

This term pupils will be looking at space adventure stories. Some of the stories we will be studying are: Man on the Moon, Bob and the Moon tree, Welcome to Alien school and Aliens love underpants. Pupils will develop the following writing skills:



- Develop their narrative writing skills by creating their own space adventure stories.
- Looking at stories by the same author
- Writing a set of instructions
- Create an information booklet
- Participating in role play/drama activities.
- Develop punctuation, grammar and spelling skills, focusing on suffix endings; -s, -es, -ing, -ed, -ly, -est, -er.
- Handwriting- Work on presentation & letter formation. Year 2's will develop cursive writing.
