- Observe and recreate an African pattern on a pebble using paint.

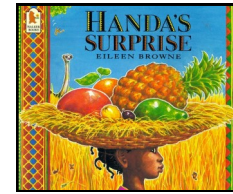
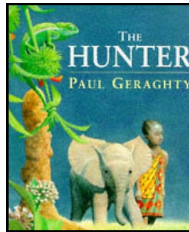
Mathematics

Throughout this term pupils will be learning:

- Time taken (second, minute, hour)
- Measure length and height using cm.
- Capacity and Volume (ml /litres)
- Money
- Multiplication and Division

Music

- Pupils to explore the sounds of Africa and respond using dance and movement (Lion King)
- Look at African rhythms and follow a simple sequence using percussion instruments.

Geography

- To name and locate 7 continents and 5 oceans.
- To use simple compass directions North, South, East and West.
- Understand geographical similarities and differences between England and Kenya.

Science

- To group, compare and classify animals based on their structures and features.
- To sort and identify which animals are herbivores, omnivores and carnivores.
- Learn how animals adapt to their habitat and environment.
- Learn how animals depend on each other to survive. (producer, consumer and predator)

Literacy

This term pupils will be looking at Africa themed stories. Some of the stories we will be reading in class are: The Hunter, Handa's surprise, Handa's hen, The lion inside and many more. Pupils will practise the following skills:

- Write their own stories with a clear beginning, middle and end. based on a story they've read.
- Create a fact file about an animal found in Africa using I.C.T.
- To write a letter to a penpal in Kenya using our CAFOD connections.
- Write a recount about a real event.
- Write a set of instructions to make an African mask.
- Continue using correct spelling, punctuation and grammar within their every day writing.
