We are thrilled to have been donated with a fabulous new worldwide, online resource called **Pobble**. Pobble is an educational platform, designed by and for teachers to help improve children's writing. You will be aware that we believe in exciting writing methods for our children and undertake writing in a multimodal way: shape books, pop-up books and all things creative. We will be publishing your child's work online (with your consent) and you will be able to see your child's work under our school name. Every week, your child's teacher will select "**published authors**". Their work will be published on Pobble and shared with the school community and with a **global audience**. Pobble improves engagement and attainment.

Every day, thousands of teachers use Pobble with their class. Reading another child's work sparks inspiration and we use self and peer assessment daily to keep moving children's writing skills forward. An authentic audience provides purpose and builds self-esteem and Pobble is a great way in which to promote children's love of writing. We are very excited about this.

We ask you to join your child on this learning journey.

- **1 Provide permission for your child**

When your school starts using Pobble, you will receive an email to ask whether you want your child to participate. If you consent, two things happen:  
your teacher can publish their work on Pobble,  
your child will get their own Pobble pupil account.

- **2 Connect to your child's account**

Next, you can sign up for your own Pobble account. It will be linked to your child's.

- **3 Read and comment on your child's work**

When your child's work is published on Pobble, they will be very excited. You will receive an email when this happens. Remember to leave a comment, because yours are the most important of all!

- **4 Read and leave comments together**

With their pupil account, your child can leave comments on other children's work. You could access Pobble together at home.
