HOW WE COMMUNICATE WITH YOU



We always try our best to communicate with parents and guardians effectively, we invest a lot of time and consideration to communicate in the best possible way (such as introducing the School App and Seesaw for example). Please do give school any constructive feedback, to enable us to improve in our communication further. Here are the means of communication that we use and some reasons why we use them.

School App – this comes directly from the school office, teachers do not have access to the database and use of the app. We have had some technical issues (from the company that maintain the app). This was put in place to cut down on text messaging, due to the enormous costs from texting out to all parents/guardians. Please ensure your app is updated and notifications are turned on.

Text Messaging – Used by the school office, only if needed and for personal messages (such as school closures or if we cannot get in contact via phone calls.)

Seesaw – used by teachers, as a way of bringing parents/guardians inside the classroom, so you can see what wonderful work is being done by your children. It is also an effective way for teachers to send out any newsletters, class messages and to get any confidential messages out there to parent/guardians.

E-mailing – used by the school office to send out newsletters. This has been put in place in an attempt to cut down on the use of paper, in consideration of our need to help the environment. Also used if we cannot get in contact via phone calls.

Website – we have recently update our website, to make it more functional. We have class pages; where you can see what the children have been learning about, as well as all policies and information about school. There is now a Kids' Zone, which we will be developing with the children next term.

Twitter and Facebook – Used by the school office and teachers to share the latest information and school events.
