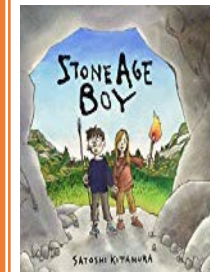

### English

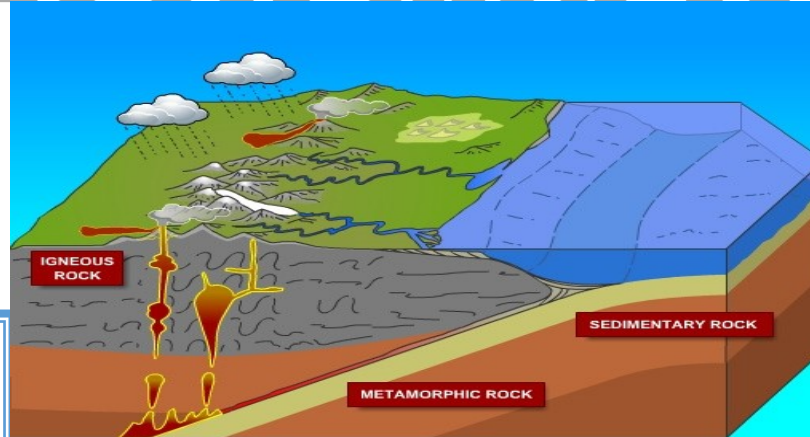
English learning will focus on a story as a theme and discussion - presenting different points of view.

Linked to our Topic learning the children will write a narrative based on a Stone Age story. They will write a discussion text based on 'Would you prefer to live in the Stone Age or in the present day?'



Prepositions, inverted commas for dialogue, paragraphs and exploring, identifying and creating complex sentences using a range of conjunctions will be the grammar focus for the half-term.

# Rock and Roll!



### Topic

**Science:** The children will be comparing and grouping different kinds of rocks on the basis of their properties; describing how fossils are formed; recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter and that rocks and soils can be different in different environments.

**Geography:** The children will be learning to locate the world's countries and identifying the position and significance of latitude, longitude, Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere. Physical geography learning will relate to volcanoes and earthquakes and human geography will focus on types of settlement and land use.

**History:** The children will be learning what life was like in Ancient Britain and about Stonehenge.

### Mathematics

Throughout this half-term the children will be learning about:

- Place value.
- Mental calculation and written methods for multiplication and division.
- Fractions.
- Measurement— volume, capacity and mass.
- Statistics.
- Problem solving.
