### **Mathematics**

Throughout this half-term the children will be learning about:

- Place value
- Mental calculation and written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
  - Fractions and decimals.
    - Measurement.
    - Problem solving.

### **Topic**

**Science:** The children will be learning about Forces and recognising that some forces need contact between two objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance.

**Design and Technology:** The children will be designing, making and evaluating an Iron Man moving picture book for Key Stage 1 children.

Art: Inspired by the Iron Man the children will make observational drawings of cogs, chains, spanners and tools. Creating images of the Iron Man will develop both drawing and painting skills.

Music: The children are going to study the music of Marvel Studios - home to the Iron Man movie franchise. This will then lead them to investigate the impact of music on film trailers and films in general before they then compose their own music or special effects to a trailer of their choice.
