

School Times for 2023/24

New DfE guidance has stated schools must have a school day consisting of 32.5 hours per week. Therefore, from September our school day *FOR ALL CLASSES* is: Arrive from 8:45am, register to be taken in class at 8:50am. Anyone arriving after 8:50am will receive a late mark. The school day will finish at 3:20pm.

Uniform

Pleas ensure you child has the correct uniform for both PE days and non-PE days. The uniform is stated on the website, if you are unsure of what your child is required to wear. Please ensure children have the correct footwear on for the correct day. Trainers are not to be worn on school uniform days.

Pick Up and Drop Off - Reminder for Parents/Guardians

A reminder for parents/guardians of children in Year 2, going into Year 3. When picking up/dropping off your child remember to use the main school entrance and the first car park on your left for the older children (unless there is a sibling in the lower year groups). A reminder that children must not play on the equipment or play football in the playground after school.

Attendance

We have seen a dramatic rise in families taking holidays during school time. Just to make you aware, if your child is off for 5 days for a holiday in a term, each parent/parental guardian will receive a penalty notice from Lancashire County Council. We know it can be difficult due to costs, we feel it too as staff, but it is incredibly important that your child is in school for the whole academic year. From September, Lancashire County Council have allocated attendance officers for all schools to ensure schools are doing all they can to ensure children are in school for the whole academic year.
