Car Park

Uniform

Please ensure children have the correct, full uniform on including black school shoes. Trainers may only be worn on PE days. Hoop earring are not permitted as part of the uniform, one stud earring in each ear is allowed. For PE days, we recommend no earrings to be worn, but children can wear a plaster over their earrings, the plaster has to be put on by a parent or the child themselves.

School Meals

Just to remind families of a price increase for school meals from September, the price will slightly increase to £2.40 per meal. School meals will remain free for all children in Reception, year 1 and year 2.

Polite reminder

Just to remind all parents that you need to contact the school office regarding attendance matters, rather than contacting through Seesaw. Having Seesaw is a brilliant tool, where you have direct access to your class teacher.
